## The Great Reality of Jesus Resurrection Body

John 21:1-14

Pastor Robinson invites you to join him for Wednesday evening Bible Study as we embrace the essence of the Lenten season.

The bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ is the most important event in history, providing irrefutable evidence that Jesus is who He claimed to be – the Son of God. The resurrection was not only the supreme validation of His deity; it also validated the Scriptures, which foretold His coming and resurrection. Moreover, it authenticated Christ's claims that He would be raised on the third day (<u>John 2:19-21</u>; <u>Mark 8:31</u>; <u>9:31</u>; <u>10:34</u>). If Christ's body was not resurrected, we have no hope that ours will be (<u>1 Corinthians 15:13</u>, <u>16</u>). In fact, apart from Christ's bodily resurrection, we have no Savior, no salvation, and no hope of eternal life. As the apostle Paul said, our faith would be "useless" and the life-giving power of the gospel would be altogether eliminated.

The central theological belief in Christianity, Jesus' resurrection, signifies a transformed, yet physical body, demonstrating victory over death and offering hope for eternal life and a future resurrected body.
