

The Seven Deadly Sins Week 14 Wednesday 11-19-2025

In the Bible these sins are not explicitly listed as a deadly sin as we see the list of sins that have the power to keep us from entering the Kingdom of God, but they are all mentioned throughout the Bible!

- **1 Corinthians 6:9-10**

- 9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither **fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,**
- 10 **Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners,** shall inherit the kingdom of God.

Questions:

Why are these sins called the seven deadly sins?

- They are damaging to the covenant relationship with God causing physical and spiritual death!

Why are they considered to be different from other sins?

- It is believed that these sins give birth to other forms of immoralities.

The Seven Deadly Sins

1. **Pride** An excessive view of one's self without regard for others. It is often considered the root of all other sins!
2. **Greed** An excessive pursuit or love of material goods and wealth beyond necessity.
3. **Lust** A disordered desire for or enjoyment of sexual pleasure, or a strong passion for something like money or power.
4. **Envy** A selfish sadness at the prosperity of others, sometimes united with a desire to destroy it.
5. **Gluttony** A disordered or excessive appetite for food and drink.
6. **Wrath** Strong, uncontrolled anger and hate towards another person, often a desire for vengeance.
7. **Sloth** Physical laziness or, more seriously, a spiritual apathy and weariness or distaste for spiritual goods that leads to a neglect of duties.

Pride:

1. **Pride** An excessive view of one's self without regard for others. It is often considered the root of other Deadly Sins!
 - God hates Pride because it is an enemy of His Will
 - **Proverbs 8:13**
 - ◆ 13 The fear of the Lord is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.
 - Pride has the power to separate you from the provision and protection of God
 - **Proverbs 16:17-19**
 - ◆ 17. The highway of the upright is to depart from evil: he that keepeth his way preserveth his soul.

- ◆ 18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- ◆ 19 Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.
- **Proverbs 29:23**
 - ◆ 23 A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.
- Pride has the power to keep love from being shared and growing:
- **1 Corinthians 13:1-4**
 - ◆ 1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.
 - ◆ 2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.
 - ◆ 3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.
 - ◆ 4 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,
